Since teaching a student from a Biblical point of view will be impossible without the proper environment at home, we assert that a parent must be . . .

1. A member in “good standing” of Calvary Baptist Church.
2. Actively involved in a ministry of Calvary Baptist Church. **Please list areas of active involvement!** _____

3. Faithful to the regular services of the church as well as special evangelistic meetings, mission conferences etc.
4. In full agreement with the philosophy of the school and willing to sign a statement of endorsement to this fact.
5. Willingly involved in the educational process of their child as evidenced by:
 - a. Ensuring homework completion
 - b. Supporting decisions of the teacher and administration
 - c. Volunteering time to the school ministry
 - d. Supporting any disciplinary actions of administration in reference to the child
 - e. Attending CBA functions, such as the secondary play, Fine Arts Night, etc.
6. Willing to be interviewed by either the Administrator of the school or by the Pastor of the church.

We also assert that for a child to be admitted to Calvary Baptist Academy they must be . . .

1. Saved by the age of thirteen years old.
2. Faithful to all of the regular services of the church as well as well as special evangelistic meetings, mission conferences, etc
3. Shown to exhibit acceptable behavior.
4. Interviewed by either the Administrator of the school or by the Pastor of the church to determine the student’s attitude toward the school.
5. Shown to exhibit a cooperative attitude toward the school ministry as well as toward the authority of the teachers.
6. Of reasonably good health and intelligence and not requiring special education (Our school is not equipped or staffed for such a need).
7. Free from all communicable diseases.
8. Be six years old by September 1st in order to enter first grade.
