STATEMENT OF COOPERATION ~ for Non-CBC Members

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING!

1. We understand that the doctrinal beliefs held by Calvary Baptist Church and Academy will be taught in the school classrooms as they relate to all subjects, as well as in Bible classes.
2. We agree to have our child in regular attendance in Sunday School and church where God's Word is preached, believed, and obeyed.
3. We grant permission to the school authorities to discipline our child using whatever disciplinary measures are necessary, including corporal punishment. We further agree to cooperate and discipline our child in the home. We understand that any student is subject to review for dismissal by the administration at anytime.
4. We have read and understand the contents of the Student/Parent Handbook.
5. We give our permission for our child to take part in all school activities, including school-sponsored trips away from the school premises. We absolve the school, the church, and its staff from liability should our child be injured at school or during any school activity.
6. We consider it a privilege to have the opportunity to send our child to Calvary Baptist Academy and shall endeavor to support and uphold the principles, practices and educational policies of the academy in every way.
7. We realize that we as parents must maintain a proper attitude towards the school, its staff and its policies. Therefore, we will not criticize the school, its staff or its policies in front of our children or other adults. We realize that failure to maintain this principle may result in the dismissal of our child.
8. We agree to uphold and support the high academic standards of Calvary Baptist Academy by providing a place at home for our child to study and will give our child encouragement in the completion of homework and assignments.
9. We recognize, that for our child to make good progress in his work, it is essential that he have confidence in his teacher and school. Therefore, we will do all in our power to see that our child respects and obeys the school staff and rules. We agree that if our child should become involved in any difficulty with another child in the school, we will seek to resolve the problem in a Biblical manner and with only those people involved.
10. We will see to it that our child adheres to the dress code of Calvary Baptist Academy.
11. **We agree to pay the first tuition payment by the first of August.** We understand that the other nine payments are due on or before the first day of the next nine months, which are September through May. Any account not paid by the 10th of each month will be assessed a **\$25.00** late fee per month, and that any child whose parents' account is 30 days overdue will be subject to dismissal from the school.
